The coaches will be loading at North Gwinnett at 6:00am and departing at 6:15am. The varsity athletes should arrive by 7:20am and text a coach when they are leaving for the meet. The JV Championship runners should be at the team tent by 8:15am. The Open JV runners should be at the tent no later than 9:00. This gives you plenty of time in case of emergency when traveling to the meet.

- *It is expected of everyone on the team to cheer for all races and stay around to accept any team or individual awards that we might earn unless you are cleared by a coach. This is the Area/Region Championship and this is what we have trained all season long for and we should take great pride in how we do at this race!*
- **If you are injured, you are required to arrive by 8:30am.**
- **Managers should arrive by 7:30am.**

Awards: Trophies to the top 3 teams in the varsity races and top 2 teams in the JV-A race. Individual awards will be given to the top 25 in the varsity races and top 25 in the JV races. *Top 10 Individual Awards for the Varsity Races will be given out in the award's presentation.

Uniforms must be the same for Varsity Races.

Reminders for athletes and parents:

- Trash – please help pick up around team areas...trash must be bagged.
- NO dogs will be allowed at the course or at the park.
- Parking should be similar to how it was handled at the county meet.
- All athletes will receive a number and pins.

Top 12 individuals in the varsity races

Top 6 teams in the varsity races advance to the state meet on November 4th at Carrollton.

DIRECTIONS: **Georgia International Horse Park**
 1996 Centennial Olympic Parkway
 Conyers, GA 30013

Take Exit 82 off Interstate 20 in Conyers. Travel North approximately 4 miles. Turn right onto Centennial Olympic Parkway. The main entrance to the Park is 2 miles ahead on the right.

An alternative route to the Park is via Salem Road (Exit 84) off Interstate 20. Take Exit 84 and travel North approximately 1 mile. At Gees Mill Road, turn right and the Georgia International Horse Park Gate A is 2.5 miles on the right. To continue to the main gate (Gate C), continue past Gate A and turn right at the stop sign onto Centennial Olympic Parkway. The main entrance will be on your right.

Alternate Route (Non Interstate) GA 20 East to right on Rosebud. Continue on to Miller's Bottom Road (formerly Rosebud). Turn right on GA 138 West to left on to Costley Mill Rd. Take a right on Gees Mill road then your 1st left to stay on Gees Mill Road. Follow signs to race.

Make sure to bring: UNIFORM, EXTRA SOCKS, RACING SHOES (if you own them), WATER BOTTLE AND DON'T WEAR JEWELRY!! DO NOT SHOW UP IN FLIP FLOPS EITHER. Dress in layers as it will be cold in the morning. No metal is to be worn in hair or anywhere. You may wear your watch. THE RACE OFFICIALS WILL BE ABSOLUTELY STRICT ABOUT THE RULES SINCE THIS IS THE QUALIFIER FOR STATE... VARSITY MUST HAVE EXACT SAME UNIFORMS AS WELL... WITHOUT EXCEPTION OR WE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

Please make sure you have transportation worked out or let me know that you need a ride. Everyone MUST be at the tent at the designated time above. If you are not AT THE TENT at the designated time before your race, you run the risk of not racing! This is for your safety to prevent injuries by not being properly prepared for a race. Everyone is expected to stay until the awards ceremony is over.
